Registration Policies

Your 2026 dues must be paid to enroll at the member rate. If your Project is not a current member of Affordable Housing Providers of Oklahoma, please enroll at the nonmember rate. Your registration fee must be received by July 15th, to take advantage of the early registration rate. After July 15th, you must pay the full fee. All registration forms must be accompanied by payment in full. AHPOK accepts Checks Only Please.

Cancellation Policies

Cancellations received in writing to AHPOK office by July 15th, 2026 will receive a full refund. Requests received between July 16th and August 15th will be refunded at 50%. No refunds will be issued after August 15th, 2026.

Registration Hours

Pre-registered attendees may pick up their packets from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm on Wednesday, September 9th. You may enroll onsite during convention hours. The registration/information desk will typically be open beginning at 7:30 am during the convention.

Spouse/Children's Program
